CURRENT PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

I am a partner in The Americas Group Real Estate which is a consulting, marketing and merchant banking firm focusing on Latin America. The company develops Latin American market entry strategies for U.S. companies and United States market entry strategies for Latin American companies.

RECENT PROFESSIONAL ACTIVITIES

I served as the Executive Director of the Center for Real Estate Development, Kenan-Flagler Business School, University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill from 2004 through 2007. I currently am an adjunct professor occasionally lecturing and assisting in the management of a student run real estate development fund. Highlights of my tenure as Executive Director include the launch of an intercollegiate real estate development case competition and creation of a student managed real estate development investment fund both of which are first for a business school. Our Center also obtained a UN grant to manage a tsunami redevelopment project in Thailand. I also taught the 6 hour capstone real estate development class for second year MBA students who concentrated in real estate development. In November 2008, I was awarded the Business School's annual Merit award for an MBA graduate.

I serve as a board member of Grubb Properties, Inc., one of North Carolina's oldest and largest urban mixed use developers. Grubb has a related investment entity that is run essentially as a private REIT.

Until March of 2009 when the company was sold, I served as a member of the board of directors of American Land Lease, a NYSE listed REIT.

PRIOR BUSINESS EXPERIENCE

Pulte Homes, Area President for Florida

I was responsible for the \$1+ billion in revenue Florida homebuilding operation encompassing the Pulte, DiVosta, and Del Webb brands. The Florida area was Pulte's most profitable and the entities that reported to me were recognized as the top area and division in the company each year. Prior to my assignment as president of the Florida Area, I was responsible for creating a strategy and launching Pulte's international

operations in Chile and Argentina. In this capacity, I lived in Santiago, Chile and negotiated strategic partnerships with firms in both Chile and Argentina

I joined TCR in 1989 and was responsible for the management and development of Harbour Island, a 177 acre mixed use development owned by Beneficial Corporation in downtown Tampa. Over my 7 year tenure at Harbour Island, the community grew from 200 residents to more than 2000 and was repositioned as one of Tampa's most exclusive neighborhoods.

I held various employee and independent partner roles while working closely with Charles Fraser, the founder of Sea Pines and one of the legends in the resort retirement community development industry.

President, Carolina Venture Capital Corporation

Carolina Venture was a small SBIC licensed by the SBA that invested in 20 small rapidly growing businesses. My significant board experiences included the nation's fastest growing regional airline, a publishing company of a high end outdoor magazine and books, and a developer of student condominium projects. The largest company whose board I was a member of for 12 years was Performance Bicycle, the largest retailer of bicycle clothing and equipment in the USA.
